## Terms and Conditions

A Spotlight on Lockdown is an initiative run by Rugeley Town Council. Its aim is to encourage all artists in Rugeley to make an original piece of work which reflects their lives over the past year.

### **Closing Date for applications: Friday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2021**

The Spotlight on Lockdown Exhibition will be held in the Rugeley Rose Theatre from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020. The exhibition will be filmed and recorded and placed on social media and the Town Council and Rose Theatre websites. Recordings of the artwork will be held as part of a developing archive of works which capture Rugeley's history.

There is no guarantee that your artwork will be included in the exhibition, but every attempt will be made to display the maximum number of pieces.

Should Government restrictions be lifted, the Spotlight on Lockdown Exhibition will be open to the public and a launch event will be held to which the press will be invited.

Artwork will not be returned at the end of the exhibition unless separate arrangements are made through the Town Clerk. Any artwork not returned or used in and around the Rose Theatre and Town Council will be destroyed.

Your submission can take any reasonable form including but not limited to paintings, photographs, spoken word, videos, sculpture, textiles or poetry.

We ask that your artwork is original and was created within the last 12 months.

By submitting an entry using the Town Councils entry form, you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.
