Rugeley Town Council agreed to support the idea of an urban greening throughout Rugeley parish. The aim of the scheme is to promote groups and individuals to grow fruit and vegetables where they will be freely available.

Fruit and vegetables can be grown in planters in a school playground, in window boxes, on patches of disused land (providing permission is sought from the landowner) etc.



The aim of the scheme is threefold: to encourage the eating of more fruit and vegetables in the community; to bring back into use disused areas of land – even if only temporarily; to brighten up

the local environment.

In order to support all involved in the scheme, Rugeley Town Council will be offering grants to assist in the purchase of planters, soil and plants.
