An artist had been commissioned to interpret the submissions made by local school children and some of the cooling towers would be available to view on the 23<sup>rd</sup> October. A display of the artwork was on show during the meeting.</p> <p>Officers have been working with Keele University and Zero Carbon Rugeley to develop a Green Energy Day which will be held in the Rose Theatre between 12noon and 7pm on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> October. Partners who are involved in Zero Carbon Rugeley will be talking about their work. Stalls will be taken by those providing eco friendly products. Food stalls will be on site and public attending will be given £8.50 food vouchers to spend on the day with one of the two food trucks. Films which show climate change issues will be shown for the children throughout the afternoon and early evening and will be free of charge. Funding for the day is coming from Keele University and partners.</p>
