<b>43</b> 43.1	<b>Downfall Abbey</b> Cllrs received a report for the event which was the first of its kind held in the Rose Theatre. The event had been well attended and a profit had been made on the event more than the income from the room hire lettings. The event had been well received although the quality and amount of the food was questioned and the need for desserts to be plated.

<b>44</b> 44.1	<b>Theatre Managers Report</b> Cllrs had all received a report from the Theatre Manager in advance of the meeting.	
44.2	<b>Electrical Inspection and Testing</b> The electrical testing for the theatre has been done. A socket has been fitted behind the bar to allow for the installation of the cocktails.	
44.3	<b>Air Conditioning</b> The air conditioning has been serviced and the new control screen will be fitted on 21 <sup>st</sup> July.	
44.4	<b>Rugeley Art Class</b> The Rugeley Art class were seeking permission for an exhibition between 10am - 6pm on the Friday 23 <sup>rd</sup> September 2022 It was proposed that we allow the exhibition to take place and open the bar for visitors to the exhibition. <i>Proposed: Cllr Green, Seconded; Cllr Cooney</i> <b>The motion was agreed.</b>	
44.5	<b>Display Screens</b> Cllrs received the quotes for screens to be placed in the Rose Theatre bar area for advertising future events. It was suggested that we offer local businesses the chance to advertise on them. It was felt that the screens need to be large, and we need to understand the costs involved in setting them up.
