6.1	Cllrs had received details of the current and proposed 3 year budgets. The current projections showed that between £20k and £24k may need to be found from balances to cover costs. Assumptions have been made on future budgets that inflation will be around 4%. Assumptions have also been made that bookings at the Rose Theatre will get back to at least where they were before the pandemic.	
6.2	It was proposed that an increase in the precept be agreed of 3.46% for a Band D property which equated to around £2 per year increase / 4 pence

It was further proposed that the budget councillors had received for 2022/2023 be approved and the indicative budgets for 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 be noted.</p> <p><i>Proposed: Cllr Stanley; Seconded: Cllr Dipple</i></p> <p><b>It was agreed that the precept be increased by 3.46% for a Band D property for 2022/2023.
